

# Visitor Information

## DAYS & HOURS OF OPERATION

- March 1st 2021 – May 9th 2021
- Open 7 Days a week
- 9 am – 6 pm

## ADMISSION & TICKETING

- For the safety of our visitors, staff, and volunteers we have shifted to a contactless ticketing system **ALL TICKETS MUST BE PURCHASED ONLINE** prior to your visit with an assigned date and arrival time window
- NO WALK-UP ENTRY
- No one will be admitted to The Flower Fields without proof of online reservation
- No cash will be taken at The Flower Fields. Credit cards can be used and food & drink vendors, Antique Tractor Rides and U-Pick blueberry
- Please arrive at your designated date & time and be sure to have your ticket displayed on your cell phone or a printed copy on hand

## WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE FLOWER FIELDS

- Please be prepared to have your admission tickets scanned (either from your cell phone or a printed copy)
- Please have face coverings on for check in
- Cloth masks or face coverings must be worn over the nose and mouth at all times by all visitors (children under 2 are exempt) except when eating or drinking
- Practice social distancing

## DURING YOUR VISIT AT THE FLOWER FIELDS

- Please stay on the designated paths during your visit
- Please maintain a physical distance of 6 feet from guests outside of your immediate family members
- Please enjoy seating on our benches (2-3 family members at a time) scattered throughout the Fields
- Please DO NOT gather in groups
- Please follow any instructions Staff may ask you to adhere to for your safety and the safety of others
- Please bring your own water, hats, sunscreen and snacks to enjoy in the Fields

## PLAYGROUND

- WEAR A MASK: Everyone 2 years and older must wear a mask covering their face
- MAINTAIN DISTANCE: Maintain physical distance of 6 feet between individuals from different households and prevent crowding of children
- NO FOOD OR DRINK: Do not eat or drink in playground to ensure face masks are worn at all times
- WASH HANDS: Wash or sanitize your hands before and after you visit
- PLAN AHEAD Visit the park at different times or days to avoid crowds and waits
- KNOW WHEN TO STAY AWAY: Elderly individuals and people with underlying medical conditions should avoid playgrounds when others are present
- SHARE OUR SPACE: To avoid crowding and allow everyone to use this space, please limit your visit to 30 minutes when others are waiting

## ANTIQUE WAGON TOUR

- Tickets are available at the Wagon Tour ticket booth inside the entrance to The Flower Fields, and are sold on a first come first served basis
- Wagon Tour tickets can be purchased at the Wagon Tour ticket booth with a mobile device or by credit card. **CASH WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**
- Wagons are regularly cleaned and disinfected
- The passenger wagon seating has been designed to allow for social distancing between unrelated parties
- Additional assistance will be provided for people with disabilities
