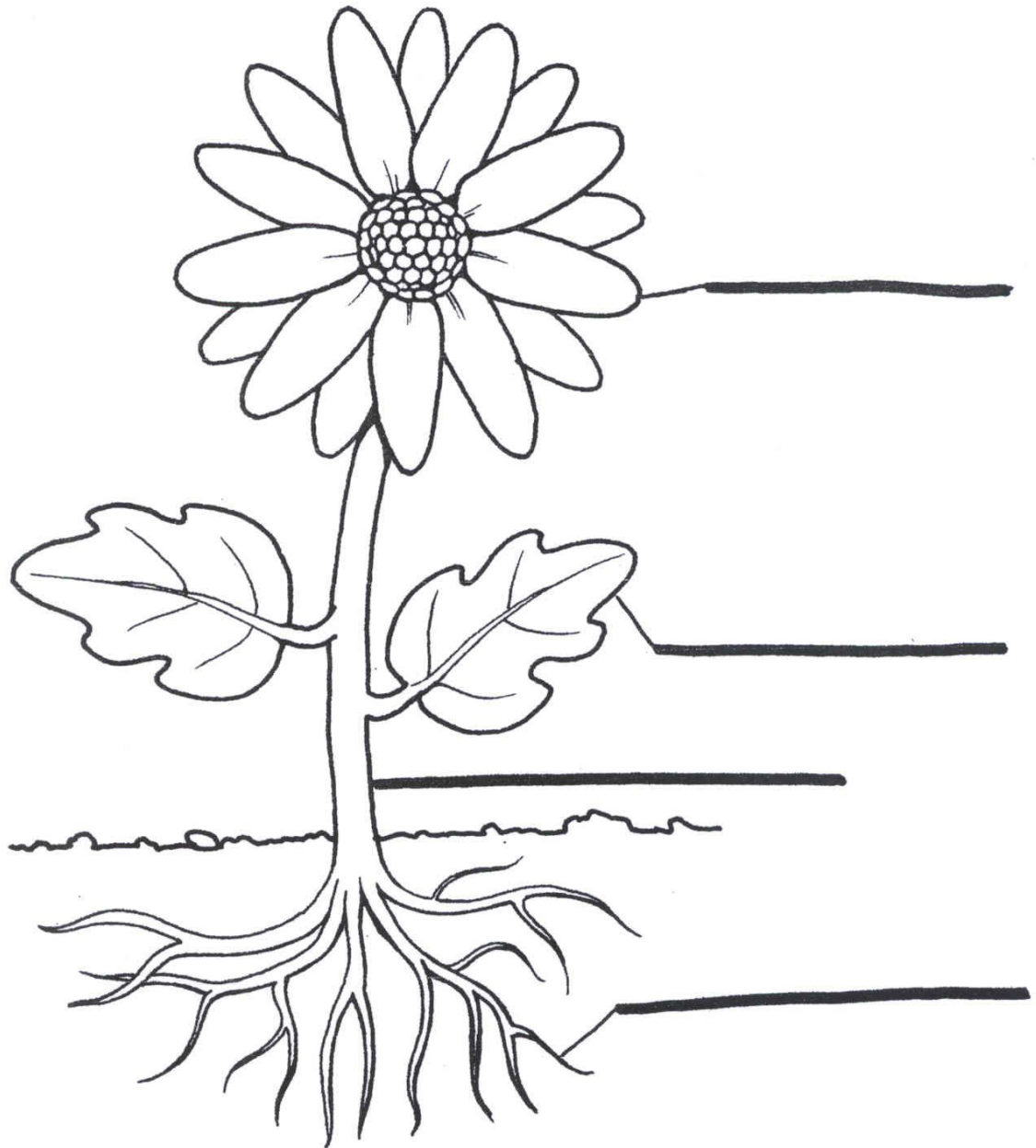


-  A plant needs air to grow. Circle two other things a plant needs to grow.

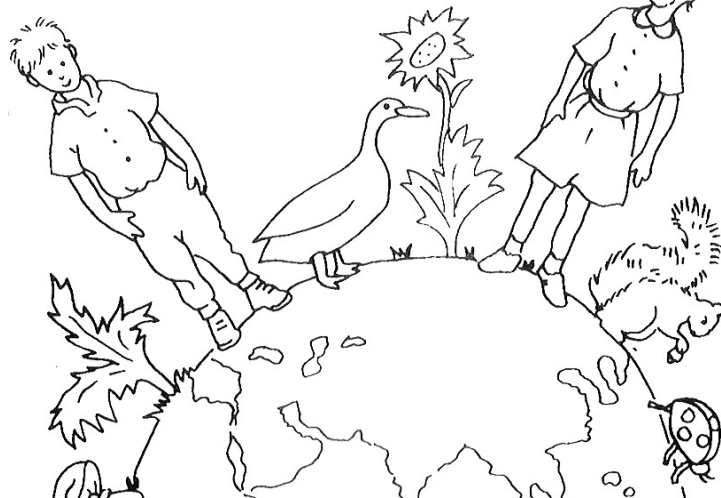
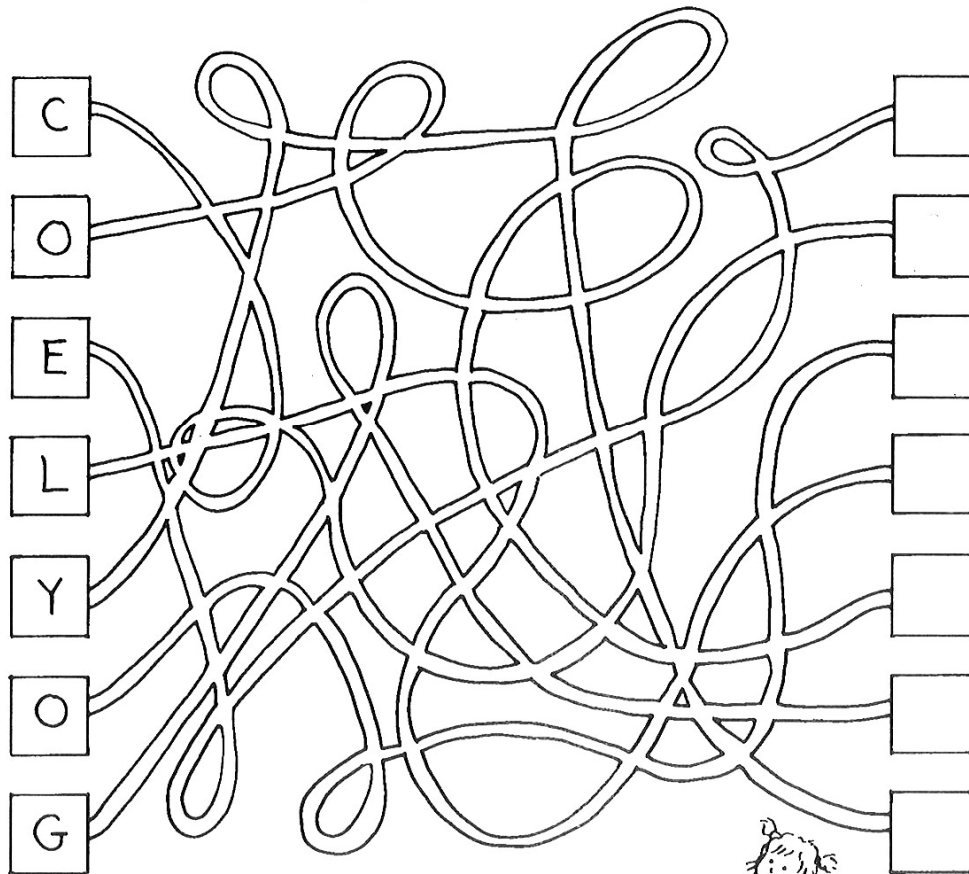


Color green the plant part that makes food for the plant.

All living things on the Earth interact with one another and with the environment.

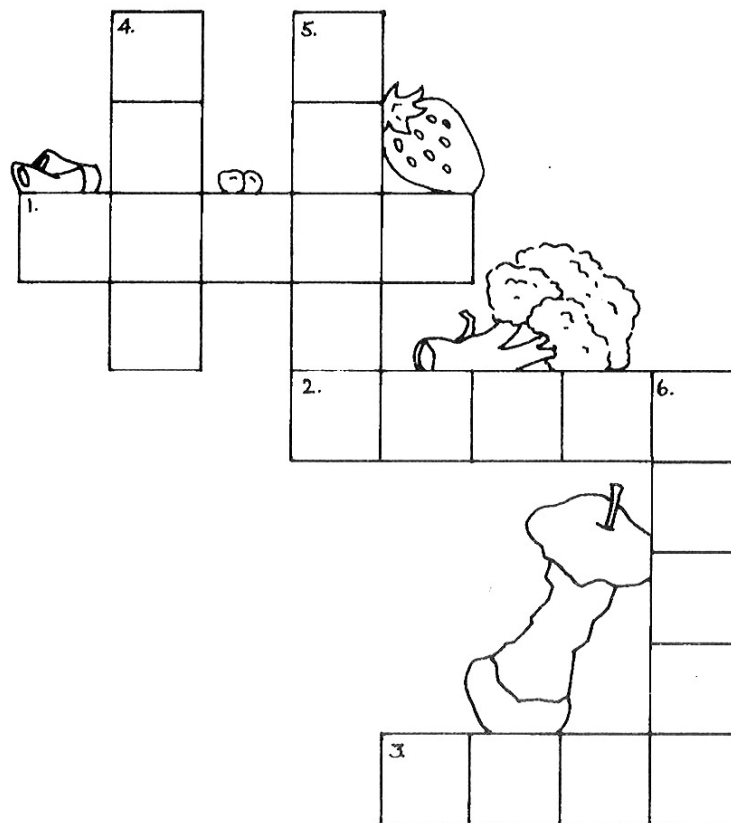
To find out what this is called, follow the squiggly lines. Write the letters in the empty boxes.

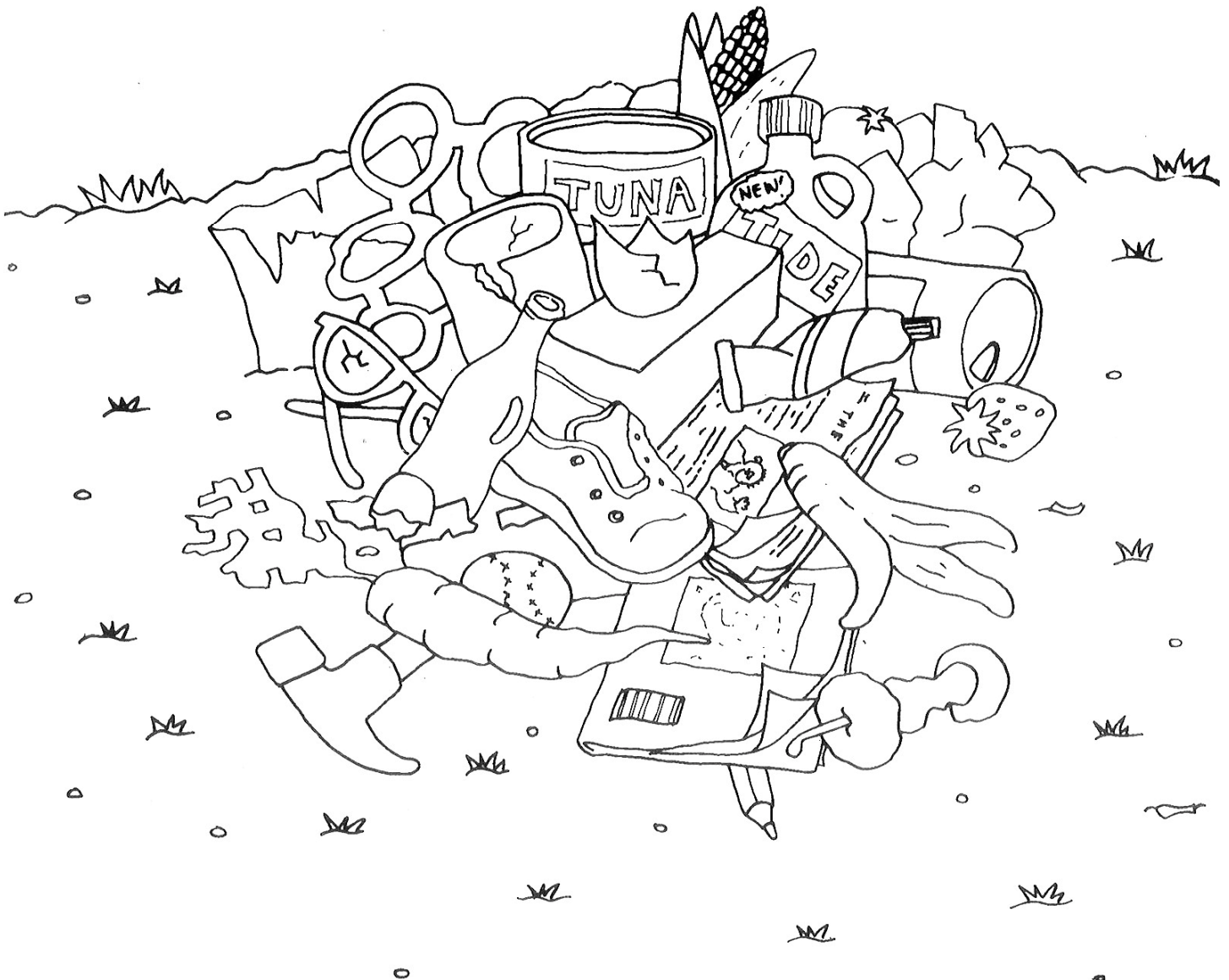
