Care Instructions for Your Ranunculus or Sunflower



- 1. After you have planted your ranunculus bulb or sunflower seeds, water them well. Saturate the soil mix, but do not allow the soil to sit in standing water. Both Ranunculus and Sunflower will perform best in full sun, so keep that in mind when you chose the location to place your pot.
- 2. DO NOT water the bulb or seeds again until you see green sprouts above the soil. Once you see the sprouts above the soil, water your plant and then continue to keep the soil mix moist by watering once every few days as needed in order to keep the soil mix moist, but not saturated. If you do NOT see green sprouts by the 7th day after planting your bulb or seeds, you may water the pot thoroughly again.
- 3. When your plant reaches 3 inches tall, you may continue to grow it in the pot provided; or, if you prefer, you may transfer it to a bigger pot or plant it in a sunny place in your yard. If you choose to grow your plant inside your house, a south-facing window would be the best location for your pot.
